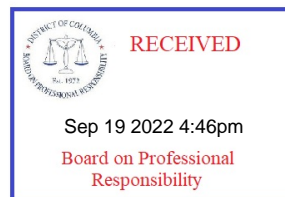

ANSWER TO SPECIFICATION OF CHARGES


COMES NOW, the Respondent, Jehan A. Carter, Esquire, by and through her attorneys John O. Iweanoge, II. and THE IWEANOGES' FIRM, P.C., hereby respond, pursuant to Rule to the Specification of Charges filed by Disciplinary Counsel by incorporating by reference her responses to Bar Counsel's request for information and further states:

1. Respondent was admitted to the Bar of the District of Columbia on January 10, 2014 and assigned Bar number 1018067.
2. Respondent admits the allegations in paragraph 2 of the petition but further states that Dominique Collier made eight allegations in her disciplinary complaint.
3. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraph 3 that she was charged with misconduct but denies that all the charges were specific and limited to the allegations in Ms. Collier disciplinary complaint. In addition, the filing of disciplinary charges does not mean that the allegations in Dominique Collier disciplinary complaint were substantiated.
4. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraph 4.
5. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraph 5.
6. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraph 6.
7. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraphs 7.
8. Respondent admits the allegation in paragraph 8.

9. Respondent admits the allegations in paragraph 9.
10. Respondent denies the allegation that she knew that her statements in the complaint at the time they were made were untrue or inaccurate or that she admitted to the allegations in Dominique Collier disciplinary complaint. The amended petition for negotiated discipline subsequently filed is devoid of specific allegations in Dominique Collier disciplinary complaint.
11. Respondent denies allegations in paragraph 11 that she violated Rule 3.3(a)(1), 8.4(c), and 8.4(d) of the District of Columbia Rules of Professional Conduct.


