The Education Department's recently released Title IX regulations governing how schools handle sexual misconduct cases on campus will affect a sea change in how schools deal with sexual harassment. - ✚ Will the new regulations bring more balance to the adjudication of Title IX cases, or will they return us to an era where sexual assault was swept under the rug?

Our panelists, who come from a diverse range of perspectives, will engage in a lively discussion of these issues, as well as rapidly evolving issues regarding protections for LGBTQ+ students under Title IX and other federal and state nondiscrimination laws.
