As Director of Research in Community Health at NPC Research, Kelly Jarvis aspires to bridge the gap between science and service by making evaluation research meaningful and accessible to social service systems, especially those serving marginalized populations. For 20 years, Dr. Jarvis has worked with organizations across a wide range of social issues, including domestic violence, homelessness, substance use, and positive youth development. Her more recent work has focused on the impacts of civil legal aid programs addressing eviction, child custody, domestic violence, elder abuse, and family guardianships. Currently, Dr. Jarvis leads the evaluation of DC's Civil Legal Counsel Projects Program, a legal aid eviction defense network, and coordinates the DC Bar Foundation's Family Law Learning Network. She also leads the statewide evaluation of California's Sargent Shriver Civil Counsel Act, which involves projects in multiple counties that collectively have provided legal services to nearly 50,000 low-income individuals.
