Jonathan Diaz is Legal Counsel, Voting Rights at the Campaign Legal Center (CLC) in Washington, D.C. CLC is a non-profit, non-partisan organization that works to advance democracy through law at the federal, state and local levels, fighting for every American's rights to responsive government and a fair opportunity to participate in and affect the democratic process.

Jonathan's work focuses on overcoming barriers to accessing the ballot, including issues related to local election administration, absentee and mail voting, the census, and the intersection of elections and the criminal justice system. He litigates voting rights cases in federal courts across the United States and advocates for laws and policies to expand access to the ballot at the federal, state, and local levels. He also frequently provides public education and commentary on voting rights issues, and recently joined CNN as an Election Law Analyst for the 2020 election cycle.

Prior to joining CLC, Jonathan was a litigation associate in the New York office of Jenner & Block LLP, where he litigated a variety of civil and criminal matters. He is a graduate of Harvard Law School and the University of Miami, and is admitted to practice in New York and the District of Columbia.
