Dr. Binny Chokshi is a general pediatrician in the Division of Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine, at the Children's National Hospital (CNH) in Washington DC. She serves at the Co-Medical Director of the Healthy Generations Program, a comprehensive program that provided teen-friendly and family-centered clinical health care and case management services to teen-headed families. Dr. Chokshi's research and education interests are focused on childhood adversity and trauma-informed care in health care settings. She has developed web-based e-modules to train outpatient pediatricians in responding to childhood adversity with a trauma-informed approach and has also trained medical students and residents at George Washington University School of Medicine and Health Sciences (GWSMHS). She has also helped to structure clinical processes at CNH related to childhood adversity, including a hospital-wide co-partnership with nursing to train hospital staff in trauma-informed care. She has a vested interest in medical education and is currently a Clinical Public Health Mentor for the Patients Populations and Systems course at GWSMHS. She has completed the Master Teacher and Leadership Development Program and is a candidate for a Master's in Education at the George Washington University School of Education and Human Development.
