Amy Mix is the Chief of the Elder Justice Section at the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) for the District of Columbia. The Section was established in 2019 to better protect the District's elders and vulnerable adults from financial abuse through civil enforcement of the Criminal Abuse, Neglect and Financial Exploitation of Vulnerable Adults and the Elderly Act, which grants OAG authority to file civil actions seeking restitution for victims and the revocation of professional licenses and the entry of injunctive relief and civil penalties for violations of the Act. Prior to joining OAG, Amy spent 16 years at Legal Counsel for the Elderly (LCE), heading up the consumer fraud and financial abuse practice. At LCE, Amy represented homeowner victims of equity-stripping schemes and other real property fraud, as well as representing clients in foreclosure defense and financial exploitation cases.
